## **CHECK LIST FOR REDUCTION OF TAIL BITING**

At observation of hanging tails or tails pressed into body (for 10 % of the pigs in a pen), or for pigs with tail bite

WELL-BEING OF PIGS	<ul> <li>Pigs with tail bite</li> <li>Increased activity - pigs clinging to boots when entering the pen</li> <li>Decreased appetite</li> <li>Depressive state of pigs</li> <li>Disease</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Take out pigs with tail bite (if necessary, move to sick pens) or mark pigs with tail bite in pens for easy observation on following days</li> <li>Treat pigs with tail bite in consultation with vet</li> <li>Observe the pen and take out: pigs with high activity/restlessness, pigs going after other pigs' tails or have blood on their head</li> <li>Take out or separate pure-bred pigs (gilts + hogs)</li> <li>Treat disease in consultation with vet</li> <li>Providing minerals can moderate increased activity of pigs</li> </ul>
FEED	<ul> <li>Empty feeding stations</li> <li>Block in automatic feeding system</li> <li>Too few feeding places - que at feeding stations</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Fill in empty feeding stations</li> <li>Clear automatic feeding system if blocked</li> <li>Increase number of feeding places – or reduce number of pigs in pen</li> </ul>
WATER	<ul> <li>Low water pressure</li> <li>Dirty water troughs</li> <li>Too few water cups/nipples - que at drinking stations</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Repair defect water cups/nipples</li> <li>Clean dirty water troughs/cups</li> <li>Give access to more water stations - or reduce number of pigs in pen</li> </ul>
LOCAL ENVIRONMENT	<ul> <li>Draught and cold: pigs freezing, huddle together</li> <li>Warmth and humidity: pigs are soiled, lying in areas with manure</li> <li>Temperature variation/change in weather</li> <li>Poor general pen hygiene incl. lying area</li> <li>Too little light</li> <li>Radiation from earth or leakage current</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Make shelter by bales of straw, partition walls or canopies. Do this in time before change of weather</li> <li>Put up weather porch or winter shreds on outdoor access</li> <li>Increase air change, establish sprinklers/wallows, increase frequency of showers</li> <li>Put in clean and dry straw/litter</li> <li>Muck out and clean dirty areas</li> <li>Check light intensity and hours with light on</li> <li>Contact electrician or specialist in leakage current</li> </ul>
STOCKING RATE	· Pigs too big or too many in the pen	· Reduce number of pigs or move to larger pen
OCCUPATION	<ul> <li>Lack of roughage of good quality</li> <li>Lack of new and fresh rooting materials for occupation</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Remove old roughage and provide fresh</li> <li>Put up more racks for roughage or provide it at different places in the pen</li> <li>Provide rooting material that can be manipulated and destroyed - robe, branches, christmas trees or the like</li> </ul>
